: An Author with Keen Observation and a Penchant for Thoughts

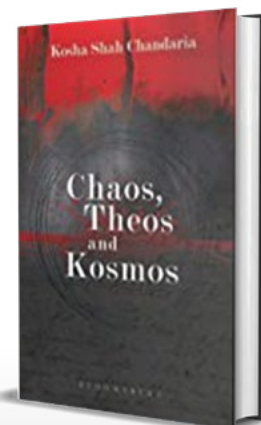

My introvert personality helped me to observe and analyze the situations and people which I used to further jolt down my thoughts and feelings. After completing my MBA, I worked for various corporates in advertising, marketing and corporate communications; delivering presentations at the start of my career. Not just the corporate sector, I have spoken at various Book Festivals, Open Mics, Book Clubs, LIT Fests and Public Libraries apart from numerous

colleges and universities all across the country. I wrote a lot of extempore topics putting society and people's behaviour under the scanner of my observant eyes. I also started writing blogs by the name of Kosmos which resulted in my first coffee table book 'Chaos Theos and Kosmos' published by the renowned publication house, Bloomsbury. Contribution of my parents and husband Brijesh and daughter Mysha cannot be just expressed in words as without their constant support, 'Chaos Theos and Kosmos' could never have been a reality.

My debut book received Ne8x literary Award for Best Book featured on World Book Day 2020 and has been nominated for Coimbatore Literary Festival. I have been invited by many renowned book cafes like Skry cafe, Oshwal Samaj, Gujarat Literature festival, NIMCJ institute and many other institutes for delivering talks on books and other related themes. I am currently Secretary at Ahemdabad Book Club, where during pandemic lockdown; we initiated projects to give platform to prominent and other authors for interviews and book promotions. My YouTube channel features many videos about various taboo topics and planning to start story reading session with my toddler bookworm daughter.

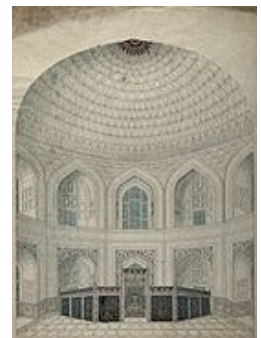
